



Guide for Authors

Submission of Papers for ISS2010 Proceedings (To be published as special issues of *Physica C*)

Manuscripts should be submitted in duplicate (one original and one copy) **by 2 November 2010 (PM 4:00)** at the symposium site. There must be a separate registered author for each paper submitted. In fairness to all authors, late manuscript will not be accepted. All the authors will be asked to supply their source files after acceptance. Please refer to a guide for **Electronic Submission of Manuscripts**.

CHECKLIST sheet The manuscript should be submitted together with the CHECKLIST sheet **ticked for each question**. You can download the CHECKLIST at Submission of Manuscript in the symposium web site.

Original material Submission of a manuscript implies it is not being simultaneously considered for publication elsewhere and that the authors have obtained the necessary authority for publication.

Types of contributions

Physica C aims to provide a rapid channel for publication of full-length papers on superconductivity and related subjects. For the sake of efficient communication, authors are requested to formulate their results in a concise and compact form. The paper-length should not exceed **4** printed pages (less than **4800** words) for contributed papers and **6** printed pages (less than **7200** words) for invited papers. Each paper should be self-contained, properly introduced with references to published work and fully documented with adequate source material.

Manuscript preparation

All manuscripts should be written in proper English. The paper copies of the text should be prepared using **double line spacing** (letter size **12**) and wide margins (**30 mm** each), on **one side** of numbered **A4** sheets. Most formatting codes will be removed or replaced on processing your article so there is no need to use excessive layout styling. In addition, do not use options such as automatic word-breaking, justified layout, double columns or automatic paragraph numbering (especially for numbered references). However, do use bold face, italics, subscripts, superscripts etc.

After acceptance

Notification You will be notified by the Editorial committee of the acceptance of your article and invited to supply an electronic version of the accepted paper.

Electronic manuscripts When you are notified that the article has been accepted, please submit electronic files by e-mail attachment or by post-mail to the Editorial Office, ISTE. Please note that no deviations from the version accepted by the Guest Editor are permissible without the prior and explicit approval by the Editor.

Proofs for correction Proofs will be sent to the corresponding author by email (PDF format). Corrected proofs should be returned following the instructions given in the covering letter within 48 hours.

Copyright transfer In the course of the production process you will be asked to transfer the copyright of the article to the publisher. This transfer will ensure the widest possible dissemination of information.

Free PDF files The corresponding author will be provided, at no cost, with a PDF file of the article via e-mail. An offprint order form will be supplied by the publisher for ordering any additional paid offprints.
