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How to prepare a manuscript for ISS2010 Proceedings (*title*)

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Abstract

The proceedings of the 23rd International Symposium on Superconductivity (ISS2010) will be published as special issues of Physica C: Superconductivity and its Applications. Submission of a manuscript implies it is not being simultaneously considered for publication elsewhere and that the authors have obtained the necessary authority for publication. Each paper should be self-contained, properly introduced with references to published work and fully documented with adequate source material. Manuscripts in duplicate (one original and one copy) should be submitted by 2 November 2010 at the symposium site. The original should include a set of first-quality figures and photographs. A disk with the electronic version (file) of the manuscript will be requested after acceptance. The files can also be sent by e-mail.

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The manuscript consists of a 'Text' and 'Graphics.' The graphics contain all figures and photographs, and the text includes all materials (items) except graphics. The manuscript should be written in proper English and neatly typed or printed on one side of A4-size sheets with 30 mm margins, using double line spacing and 12 point 'Times New Roman' and related font

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The authors of contributed papers are able to use 8 double line-spacing (letter size 12) pages for the Main Text that begins with Introduction and ends with Conclusions when the paper typically includes 15 references and 5 tables/figures. The invited papers are able to use 12 double line-spacing pages for the Main Text when the paper typically includes 30 references and 9 tables/figures.
